Officers who, day in and day out, answer the call to duty often under difficult and challenging circumstances. They are among Canada's best and are indeed, the "Pillars of the Force". This initiative also recognizes the dedicated public service employees, the community at large and families who support the Members on the front line.

The "Pillars of the Force" will open to the public at the RCMP Veterans' Association AGM in Regina, "Home of the RCMP" in June of 2020. Once opened, the "Princess Royal Walk" and the adjacent pillars along the front of the RCMP Heritage Centre will be transformed into a living legacy of those who serve and have served as it continues to grow over the following years. This initiative will also provide financial support to ensure the legacy is shared with generations to come.

THE PILLARS

A donation of \$300* ensures a 6x1.5 inch nameplate is displayed on a pillar for a member who has honourably served. The nameplate will include the member's name, regimental number and troop.
