Tom passed away peacefully on November 25, 2014 at the age of 85 years. Chief Superintendent Tom Light retired from the RCMP after 35 years of service. During his service, Tom was stationed in "F" and "D" Divisions and returned to "F" Division after being commissioned. He retired in 1983 as a Chief Superintendent. After his retirement Tom joined the Friends in 1993 and served on the Board until appointed President in 1999. Tom served as president of the Friends of the RCMP Heritage Centre from 1999 to 2008. As President, Tom was a guiding force and active participant in the planning and design of the new Heritage Centre, the transfer of the horse program and gift shop operation to the Centre, and the Friends move from the museum to the new facility. The Friends was Tom's life for many years. Tom will be sorely missed and our sympathy and prayers go out to Doreen and her family.

RCMP 'D' TROOP 1959/60 REUNION – A RETURN TO DEPOT

A group of 32 men came together at the RCMP Depot Division on September 8, 1959 and were formed in "D" Troop. This troop trained together, ate together, marched together, swam together, did morning stables together and lived together in a 32-man dormitory. They did everything together becoming a well-trained cohesive troop prepared to deal with any situation collectively or individually. Training was completed on April 29, 1960 with members posted across Canada. In most cases this was the last that many of the members had contact with one another until July 7 to 9, 2014 when 8 troop mates, including spouses came together in Regina from across Canada to celebrate their 55 year anniversary. Troop members Ken Fader and Wayne Horrocks made the Depot arrangements with the theme "A Return To Depot".

The Troop visited Depot on the 7th and 8th. Cpls Allana Graham and Sean Chiddenton, both current Depot Instructors, acted as the Troop escorts. The Troop attended two Sgt. Major's noon-day parades and were Guests of Honor at the Sunset Retreat Ceremony on the evening of the 8th. The trip was most informative as there have been many changes to Depot in 55 years. Some of the changes included: no more



equitation, many new buildings with the cadets having their own rooms, a new modern Mess to which the members of D Troop we're invited for lunch, a new indoor shooting range and the use of scenario based training. D Troop also attended the new RCMP Heritage Center which opened in 2007 and now houses the very large RCMP Historical Collections Unit.
